4. Police Department Report – Dillon presented 33 calls, 25 ordinance violations (door hanger), 3 tickets, 1 arrest




8. Angie Neely wrote a letter asking for a sewer credit her outside spigot was left on all night. Gary made a motion 2nd by Jim unanimous.
